## GUEST ROOMS

In each one of the resort's ninety Pool Villas, you'll find spectacular panoramic views, an exclusive walled garden for enjoying the region's native hibiscus and frangipani blossoms, a covered verandah and outdoor dining area, and of course, a 3.7m-long private plunge pool. Designed by local architects Macbeth, the villas are a fusion of traditional Mauritian craftsmanship and modern opulence, using local volcanic rock alongside imported marble. Whilst a stay at Four Seasons Resort Mauritius at Anahita might feel like a secret escape, guests have every modern amenity at their disposal, including wide-screen LCD TVs, iPod docking systems, Espresso machines, and wireless internet access.

## RESTAURANTS

**BEAU CHAMP:** With indoor/outdoor terrace seating for 102 guests, the Beau Champ offers fine, gastronomic Southern French cuisine a la carte with a modern twist. Chef Andreas Haugg makes the most of the island's local offerings like exotic fruit juices, as well as the finest french products. The space is complemented by a glass-walled cellar of over 200 French and international wines, including organic selections.

**O BAR:** Located steps from the main lobby and adjacent to the Beau Champ restaurant, O Bar is the perfect place to grab a midday nibble or post-dinner nightcap. Be sure to try the bar's signature drink, the aptly-named Sweet Lava: an unusual blend of mango puree with just a hint of fresh chilli pepper. It's a cocktail with a kick!

**ACQUAPAZZA:** Meaning "crazy water" in Italian, expect an eye-popping cyclone water feature and lagoon views at this open-air restaurant. Not to be outdone by the setting, the menu showcases the best in Italian cuisine, from fresh pasta and grilled seafood to pizza prepared in a wood-fired oven.

**BAMBOU:** Offering up an eclectic menu that fuses Mauritian, Indian, Thai, and Japanese cuisine, enjoy a long lunch with a side of ocean views at the resort's Pool Bar and Grill.

## SPA SERVICES

With twelve overwater treatment rooms—eight double suites for couples and four singles—the Spa at Four Seasons Resort Mauritius at Anahita offers premium services in the utmost tranquility. Inspired by the island’s wealth of natural resources, the Spa’s rituals incorporate local elements such as tamarin salt, Frangipani, and sugarcane. Don’t miss their signature treatment, the Sugar Cane Therapy Massage, which uses real sugarcane sticks for a one-of-a-kind massage that promises to leave you feeling refreshed—in both body and mind.

## ACTIVITIES

While the laid-back island environment lends itself to total rest and relaxation, there’s no shortage of fun, family-friendly activities to enjoy at the resort. Golf enthusiasts will appreciate the 18-hole, 72-par championship course: designed by Ernie Els according to USGA standards, it’s the first of its kind on the island. Divers of all levels, from beginner to pro, can participate in daily excursions to the area’s surrounding live reefs, all teeming with beautiful and brightly-colored marine life. For those seeking



a little extra adventure, big game fishing trips can be arranged by the concierge—as one of the world’s premier game fishing sites, record-breaking catches of marlin, sailfish, and even sharks are not uncommon off the coast of Mauritius. Little ones will feel right at home at the Kids Club Village, where they can make their own cookies in the “private” bakery or learn how to catch a crab, while teens will love letting loose in the video game lounge and disco area.

## RESIDENCES

With 20 two-bedroom and 12 three-bedroom Garden Villa Residences, Four Seasons Resort Mauritius at Anahita is an excellent place to enjoy an extended stay on the island. Residences are more than generously sized, with dining space for eight, two full bathrooms, and a covered poolside patio for relaxing and eating *al fresco*.
