Masai Mara & Kenya Coast

With 4 nights at Saruni Camp in the world famous Masai Mara, every member of the family, no matter what age, will become enchanted by the wildlife. Then it's a short two hour flight direct to the white sandy beaches of the Kenya coast for 7 nights enjoying the gin clear waters of the Indian Ocean and all the family orientated activities offered by Kinondo Kwetu.

Malaria-Free South Africa

Enjoy a family safari with 5 nights at Jaci's Safari Lodge (f/b) in the malaria-free Madikwe Game Reserve - South Africa's fourth largest game reserve with wildlife viewing on a par with the Kruger. Then head to Cape Town for a week in the stunning wine growing suburb of Constantia staying at the Constantia Uitsig, a short drive away from the centre of Cape Town.

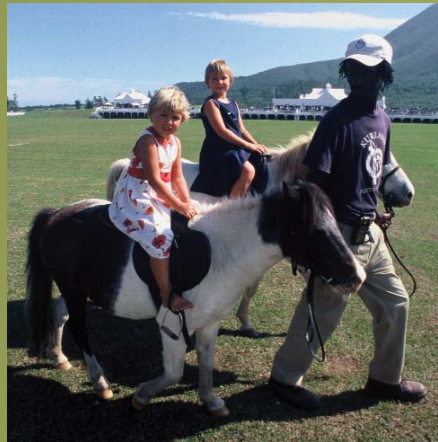
