Follow the great python curves of the Rufiji River along its wildest stretch, through the vast acres of Selous Game Reserve, and you'll eventually come upon Kiba Point: a still and deeply secret place in an expanse of bush that yields its mysteries only to the most dedicated.





Open, organic architecture brings a surfeit of space and air - luxuries in the heat of Africa. Each cottage bedroom has giant views, wide verandahs, spreading beds, plunge pool and indoor and outdoor shower. The thatched and timber mess area is a broad sweep of sofas, library, dining room and bar that looks out over an infinity pool, into the great nothingness that is the Selous.



Here - sharing the bush with some of Africa's greatest wildlife - is where you'll begin to understand the power of wilderness. A four bedroomed lodge, reserved exclusively for you and your party, Kiba Point offers the chance to commune only with nature; you won't meet another soul beyond the friends or family you've brought with you, and your private lodge staff.



Though it may be hard to drag yourself away from this intensely beautiful arena, by way of gentle persuasion you'll have your own safari guide, four wheel drives and boats at your disposal. Disappear at will on game drives, expeditions up the river, and barefoot fishing. And then again, if it's all too, too much, you might decide to give it up completely for a night's fly-camping, with bedrolls and lanterns under a trillion stars.
