Nduara Loliondo was designed to celebrate Nomadic cultures around the world; the Mongolian Gers and our own Maasai bomas. The outcome of this heady mix of culture, style, comfort and wilderness is the most amazing camp you will ever see.



Twice a year, from one huge expanse of the greater Serengeti landscape to another, Nduara Loliondo moves its yurts, shadowing the movements of a million wildebeest across the short grass plains. Essentially nomadic, migrating across the Loliondo community area which borders the Serengeti National Park proper, Nduara Loliondo takes safari life beyond the game drive. Here is where you get deeper into the bush, the wildlife, and the people of this vast area.



Being outside the official park boundaries, but still within the whole eco-system, allows greater freedoms usually only enjoyed by the locals. Simple things like night drives, and walking safaris mean an altogether more intense and real feeling of wilderness, not to mention more exciting encounters with the wild game. As people actually live in these areas, you also get to see something of tribal life, and give directly to those who are this land's custodians: we pay a significant fee to the local communities for every night you stay here, encouraging them to preserve these critical habitats.





Nduara Loliondo is all about harmony, and reflects this in a strikingly organic design. Six big, beautiful yurts have been given a totally tropical makeover, with enough light and air to do justice to the big skies and gentle climate of the Serengeti steppe, then revved up with re-invented Maasai motifs and materials.

The whimsical sleeping yurts and communal mess and dining yurts are perfect for dreaming away the high noon, or cuddling up in the dark of an African night, after a genuinely wild day out there. This camp takes pastoralism to a whole new level - bold of heart, sound of step and strong in soul.
